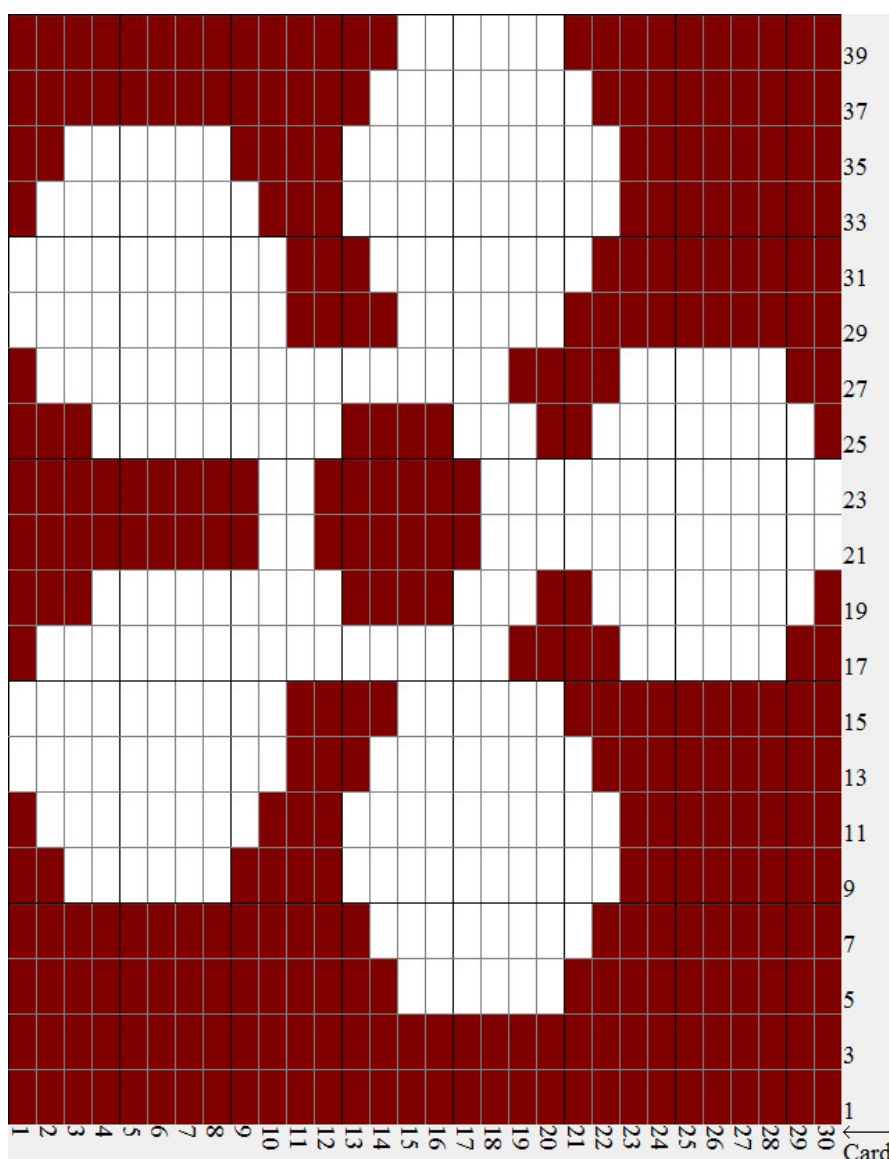

Chart 2:

Each square represents one card and two rows. The border cards are included in the pattern chart and turning sequence.

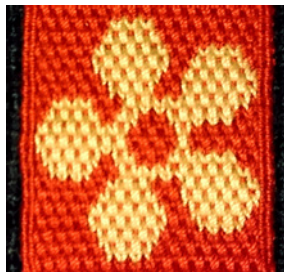
The turning sequence uses two packs: a foreground pack and a background pack.

On each row before throwing the west:

6 = Move the specified number of cards to the foreground pack. **AND** **14** = move the specified number of cards to the background pack.

Then act on the letter at the start of each row:

EITHER: **B** = Turn the background pack backwards and the foreground pack forwards. **OR:** **F** = Turn the background pack forwards and the foreground pack backwards.

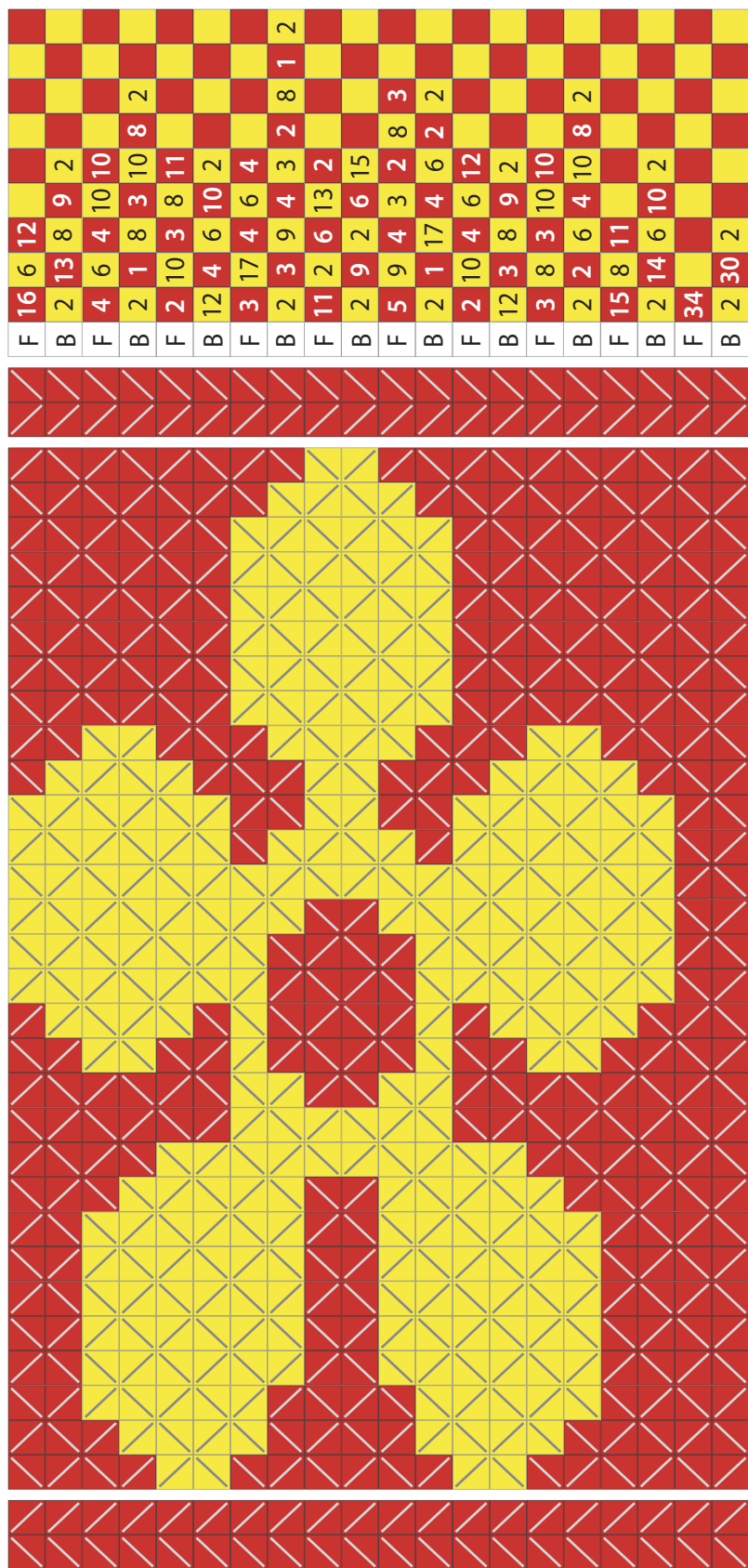

Each cell represents one card and one row.

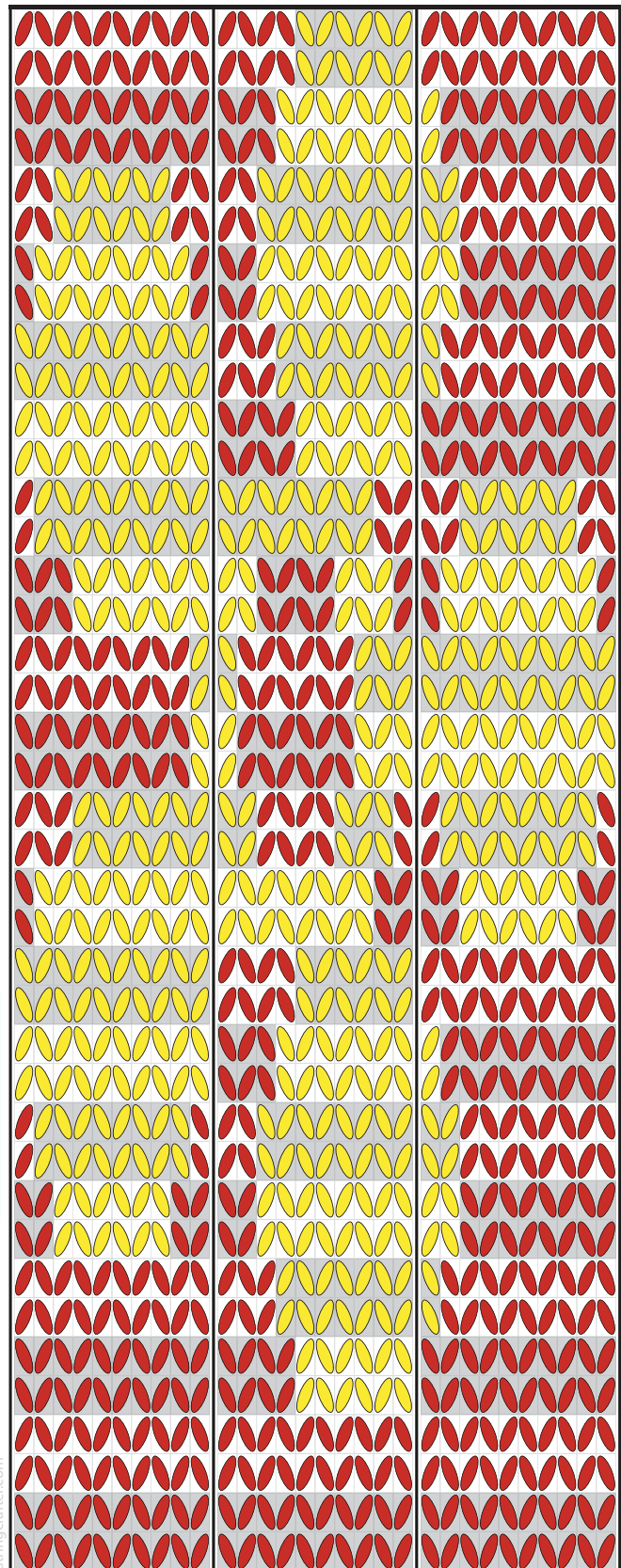

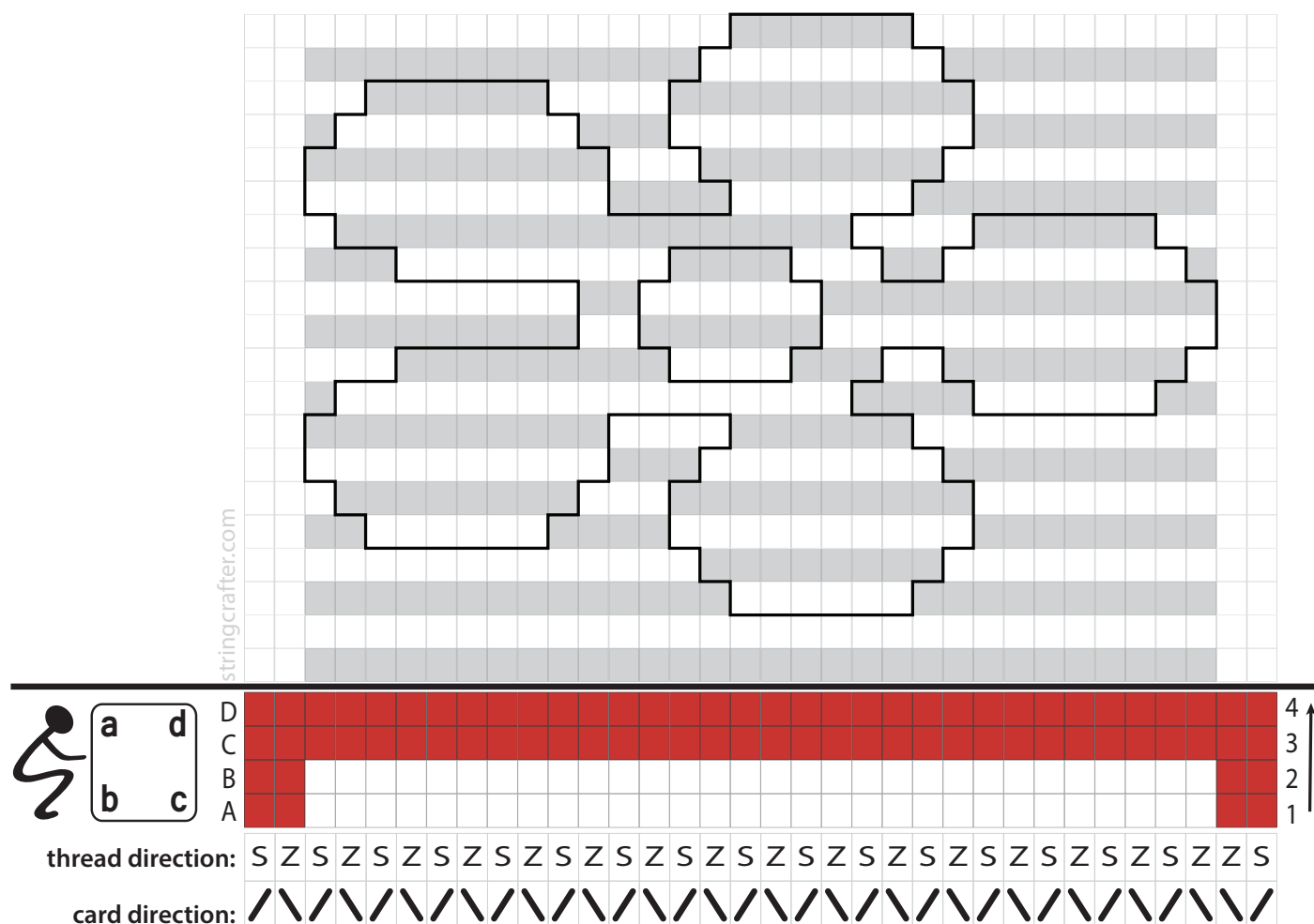


Chart 4:
